SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

Project File #13

Whereas, upon the petition of thirteen (13) legal voters, who own real estate, or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within one mile of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out four (4) rods wide, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said Town, at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit; which said proposed new road is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz:

Beginning at the Lake Josephine County Road near the southeast corner of southwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section No. 2, two, Township thirty (30), Range twenty-three (23) thence west on the section line between section two (2) and section eleven (11), to the southeast corner of section three (3), and northeast corner of section ten (10), and the northwest corner of section eleven (11), thence south on the section line between section ten (10), and section eleven (11), and between section fourteen (14) and section fifteen (15), to the southwest corner of the northwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section fourteen (14) and the southeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the northeast quarter of section fifteen (15), thence east on the half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) section line through section fourteen (14), where it would intersect with the Manomin County Road at the center of section fourteen (14).

And Whereas, upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: on the twenty-first (21st) day of November A.D. 1884, at two (2) o'clock in the afternoon at the house of Thomas Schefski in said Town in Section 11, causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said town at least ten days previous to such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant had, at least ten days previous to said time, caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway, and heard any and all reasons for or against laying out the same, and being of the opinion that such new road was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so laid out is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the Lake Josephine County Road near the southeast corner of southwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section two (2), Township thirty (30), Range twenty-three (23), thence west on the section line between section two (2), and section eleven (11) to the southeast corner of section three (3), and northeast corner of section ten (10), and the northwest corner of section eleven (11), thence south on the section line between section ten (10) and section eleven (11), and between sections fourteen (14), and section fifteen (15) to the southwest corner of the northwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section fourteen (14) and the southeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the northeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section fifteen (15), thence east on the half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) section line through section fourteen (14) where it would intersect with the Manomin County Road at the center of Section fourteen (14) in the Town of Mounds View, Ramsey County, Minnesota.

It is Therefore Ordered and Determined that a road be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying, which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is hereby declared to be a public highway four (4) rods wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.
