REMARKS:

The legal description does not appear in the road order. We found it necessary to use the description as found in the petition and is as follows:

Beginning about 20 rods North of the Southeast corner of the Southwest quarter of Section one (1), Township thirty (30), Range twenty-three (23) and running thence North on the quarter section line to the center post of said Section one (1), thence East on the quarter section line of said Section one (1) to the East line of said Section, thence East on the quarter section line of Section six (6), Township thirty (30), Range twenty-two (22) to the center post of said Section six (6), thence North on the quarter section line of said Section six (6) to the North line of said section.

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' ROAD ORDER

Whereas, A petition signed by twenty-four freeholders of said County, praying for the establishment of a certain highway in said County, running into more than one town, and not within the limits of any incorporated city, as hereinafter described, was presented to this Board at its session on the 13th day of May, 1907, and this Board having determined by the judgment of a majority of its members that said petition is reasonable on its face, and having by its order made at said session, appointed Monday the 17th day of June, 1907, at 10 o'clock A.M. at Court House and City Hall in said County, as the time and place for a hearing upon said petition, and having by said order appointed a committee of its members to examine said proposed establishment of said road and designated Friday the 14th day of June, 1907, at 3 o'clock P.M. at N.P. Sjostedt's residence in said County, as the time and place for said committee to meet on the route of said establishment road, for the examination of the same, and having caused notices of said hearing and said meeting of said committee embodying a copy of said petition, to be posted in the three most public places of each town through which said proposed establishment of said road runs, or affected thereby, at least thirty days before the day of said hearing upon said petition, and being satisfied that said notices were so posted and proof of said posting duly made, and the said committee having met at the time and place designated in said order and said notices, and examined the same and made its report in writing to this Board, and recommended that said petition be granted, and said Board having met at the time and place designated in said order and said notices, to-wit: at Court House and City Hall in said County, on Monday the 17th day of June, 1907, at 10 o'clock A.M. and duly heard all that anyone had to say in favor of, or against, the granting of said petition, and considered said petition and the report of said committee thereon, and a majority of said Board having agreed that said petition should be granted,

It is Hereby Ordered, That the prayer of said petition be and the same is hereby granted and said highway is hereby established so as to run according to said committee's report, by courses and distances as follows, to-wit:

It is Further Ordered, That the County Auditor notify the Town Supervisors of each town through which said road is established, of the fact of said establishment, and that they shall cause to be opened so much of said highway as lies in their respective towns.
