SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

Whereas, upon the petition of legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within one mile of the road proposed in said petition to be, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said town at least 20 days before any action was had in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit; which said proposed is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz: Beginning on section line between Sections 13 and 14 in T. 29, R. 22, where the S. line of the Village of North St. Paul crosses the same running thence S. along said section line and the section line between Sections 23 and 24 in said Town and Range to a point where Maryland Street in the City of St. Paul intersects the same.

And whereas, upon receiving said petition we did, within 30 days thereafter, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: on the 17th day of Sept. 1899, at Secretary of the Forest Cemetery at 10 o'clock causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said town at least 10 days previous to such meeting, and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant had at least 10 days previous to said time, caused notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway, and heard any and all reasons for or against the same, and being of the opinion that such was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to said road and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so is as follows, to-wit: Beginning on section line between Sections 13 and 14 in T. 29, R. 22, where the S. line of the Village of North St. Paul crosses the same running thence S. along said section line and the section line between Sections 23 and 24 in said Town and Range to a point where Maryland Street in the City of St. Paul intersects the same.

It is therefore ordered and determined that a road be and the same is hereby and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying, which is hereby made a part of this order, and it is hereby declared to be a public highway rods wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.
