Oct. 3, 1921 Resolved that the Town Road known as Lake Phalen Boulevard from Larpenteur Avenue running in a northwesterly direction along the shores of Lake Phalen to and connecting with the Keller Boulevard be and the same is hereby declared a County Road.

SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

May 25, 1864

The petition of Carl Deilor, Carl Reuten, W. M. Stees and others for a road was granted and the order issued, to-wit:

It is hereby ordered and determined by the undersigned Supervisors of the Town of New Canada that the following described road with the accompanying description shall be and is declared to be a public highway, to-wit:

Commencing 53 rods S. from the centre of Section 16 and running thence S. 27 rods; thence S. 40 feet to Phalen Lake; thence S. 78° E. along the Lake Shore 200 feet

> Thence S. 47° E. along the Lake Shore 50 " " S. 29° E. S. 37\frac{1}{2}^OE. S 27° E. s. 40½°E. S. 29° E. 770 " s. 46° E. 100 " s. 53° E. " S. 20½°E. 189 s. 15° E. S. 81° E up a Ravine s 16° E " to Section line on S. side of Section 16,

thence E. on Section line to S.E. corner of Section 16 - 1643 feet.
