REMARKS:

The legal description does not appear in the road order. We found it necessary to use the description as given in the petition, which is as follows:

"Beginning at the East end of a certain road which begins on the St. Paul, Lake Phalen and White Bear Road, where the Section line between Sections 1, 2 and 11 intersect said St. Paul, Lake Phalen and White Bear Road, and running East on the Section line between Sections One and Two 1 and 2, on the North and Sec tions 11 and 12 on the South about one mile at which point your petitioners ask to have this new road they are petitioning for to begin and continue on, on said line between Sections 1 and 2 on the North and Sections 11 and 12 on the South, due East to the County line between the Counties of Ramsey and Washington, the distance or length of this new road hereby petitioned for being about one mile.

Said new road will run on the lands of H.A.Castle, O.R.Carter, W.L.Hollister, W. H. Busch, and no other persons. SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

January 16, 1878

And whereas, upon receiving said petition we did, within thirty days, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and upon such application, to-wit: on the 16th day of January, 1878, at the house of Hugh Casey, on Section 2, in said Town, causing copies of said notice to be posted in three public places in said town at least ten days previous to such meeting and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice and being satisfied that the applicants had at least ten days previous to said time caused notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving them personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway and heard any and all reasons for or against laying out the same, and being of the opinion that such laying out was necessary and proper and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said Petition and determined to lay out said road, the description of which is as follows, to-wit:

It is therefore ordered and determined that a road be and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description aforesaid and it is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the description above given being the center of said road.

Given under our hands this 16th day of January A.D. 1878.
