Whereas, upon the petition of eight legal voters, residing or owning real estate within one mile of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said town at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, which said proposed new road is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz:

Commencing at a point in road 3.80 chains North of 1/4 section corner between sections 8 and 9, and running thence in Section 8 North 58 3/4 deg. West 6.00 chains, North 42 3/4 deg. West 6.24 chains, North 78½ deg. West 1.40 chains, South 52 deg. West 9.00 chains, South 42 3/4 deg. West 9.65 chains, South 41/2 deg. west 9.30 chains, South 83 1/2 deg. West 7.00 chains, north 65 deg. West 6.50 chains, North 61/2 deg. West 9.70 chains, north 12 1/4 deg. West 4.54 chains, north 35 1/2 deg. Whereas, upon the petition of eight legal voters, residing or owning real estate within one mile of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said town at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, which said proposed new road is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz:

Melancon in Section 5, causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said to town at least ten days previous to such meeting, and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice and being satisfied that the applicant had, at least ten days previous to said time, caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway will pass, proof of which place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway and all reasons for or against was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway and heard any and all reasons for or against laying out the same; there being no one present to oppose the same, and being of the opinion that such laying out was necessary and proper and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road, the description of which is as follows, to-wit:
