FINAL ROAD ORDER FOR LAYING OUT A ROAD

April 10, 1872

Ramsey County)
Town of New Canada)SS

Whereas, Upon petition signed in writing of seven legal voters residing within one mile of the route hereinafter described for a public highway, a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said town, did, on the 16th day of March A. D. 1872 personally examine the route proposed in said petition for a road, to-wit:

Commencing at a point on the road leading from St. Paul to Lake Phalen at or near the Southeast corner of Northeast quarter of Section twenty-nine (29) thence running due north along the section line between sections twenty-nine (29) and twenty-eight (28), twenty (20) and twenty-one (21), seventeen (17) and sixteen (16) in said town to intersect a road leading north from the north line of said section seventeen (17) and sixteen (16) and having before determined to lay out said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against laying out the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered for or against the laying out of said road, and being of opinion that such laying out is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road, we did, on the 16th day of March, 1872 cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor, who made report to us as follows:

It is therefore endorsed and determined that a road be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to said survey and the plat thereunto annexed and made part of this order, which is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the centre of said road.

In witness whereof, we, the said Supervisors, have hereunto set our hands this 10th day of April, 1872.
