SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

Vacating and Altering a Road

November 25, 1895

RAMSEY COUNTY)
TOWN OF WHITE BEAR) SS.

WHEREAS, Upon the petition in writing of J. H. DeJarlis, Henry Coursolle, L. C. Peltier, A. J. Peltier, Thomas Gerseau, Louis Ducharme, A. Bebeau, seven legal voters, residing within one mile of the Road hereinafter described, (the altering of which is prayed for in said petition,) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said town, did, on the 25th day of November, A. D. 1895, personally examine the route of the road proposed in said petition to be altered, to-wit:

To vacate that part of a Road which is known as the Gilfillan Road and commencing at Mississippi Street Extension and running west until Edgerton Street from Edgerton Street to Vadnais Lake that part of said Road to be kept open and vacated that part of said road running along the Northeast Shore of said Vadnais Lake until up to the quarter section line of section (32) thirty-two, Township (30) thirty, Range (22) twenty-two, and lay out a new road running on said quarter section line of section (32) thirtytwo, Township (30) thirty, Range (22) twenty-two east to Edgerton Street, distance about four hundred feet----and having before determining to alter said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the altering of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such altering of the said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to alter the said road, we did, on the 25th day of November A. D. 1895, cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor, who made report to us, as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of-----in the County of-----and State of Minnesota.

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a road beginning at-----.

Would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your directions, to-wit:

It is, Therefore, Ordered and Determined that the said Road be and is hereby altered and established according to said survey, and the plat hereunto annexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said Road.

In Witness Whereof, We, the said Supervisors, have hereunto set our hands, this 25th day of November, A. D. 1895.
