Vacation of part of Old Rice and Bald Eagle Lake Road in Section 3 and 4, Township 30, Range 22

SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

Project File #351

October 27, 1933.

RAMSEY COUNTY)
TOWN OF WHITE BEAR)SS.

WHEREAS, upon the petition in writing of eight legal voters, to-wit: Victor Nisswandt, R. A. Ball, William Molitor, Andrew Anderson, Charles A. Anderson, L. Bures, Louis Molitor and August Molitor, (8) legal voters, residing within one mile of the road hereinafter described, (the vacating of which is prayed for in said petition), a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors, of the said town, did, on the 27th day of October A. D. 1923, personally examine the road proposed in said petition to be vacated, to-wit:

Beginning at the center line of the Centerville road and running in an easterly direction to the center line of the Otter Lake road; the whole of said Town Road lying in the north half of the Northeast quarter of section four (4) Township thirty (30) Range twenty-two (22), and Government lot no. one (1) in the north half of the northwest quarter of section three (3) Township thirty (30) Range twenty-two (22), and having, before determining to vacate said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet and hear any reasons for or against the vacation of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such vacation of the said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to vacate the said road, we did, on the -----day of-----A. D. 18----, cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor, who made report to us, as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the town of-----in the County of-----and State of Minnesota.

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a road beginning at-----

Would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your directions, to-wit:

It is, Therefore, Ordered and Determined that the said road be and is hereby laid out and established according to said survey, and the plat hereunto annexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said road.

In witness whereof, we, the said Supervisors, have hereunto set our hands, this 27th day of October A. D. 1923.
