WHEREAS, Upon the petition of six legal voters, residing or owning real estate within one mile of the road to be laid out, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places in said town at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto; which said proposed new road is set forth and described in said petition as follows:

Beginning on the Section line of Section 19 and 30, at a point on said section line where the dividing line between lot 4 and the northeast quarter of northeast quarter of section No. 30 intersects the above mentioned line, or as near said dividing line as practicable, thence south on said dividing line or as near said line as practicable to the territorial road known as the Kettle River Road near Vadnais Lake.

AND WHEREAS, Upon receiving said petition, we did within thirty days make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application to-wit: on the 7th day of May A. D. 1875, at 2 o'clock in the afternoon at the house of Caspard Moosbrugger on section 19 in said town, causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said town at least ten days previous to such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant had, at least ten days previous to said time, caused said notice of time and place hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving the same personally, or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway and heard any and all reasons for or against laying out the same, and being of the opinion that such laying out was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out said road and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying:

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear, in the County of Ramsey, State of Minnesota.

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a road commencing on the section line between sections 19 & 30, Township 30, Range 22 at a point on said section line where the dividing line between lot 4 and northeast quarter of northeast quarter of section No. 30 intersects the above mentioned section line or as near said dividing line as practicable thence south to the Territorial road known as the Kettle River Road near Vadnais Lake----would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your directions, to-wit:

Commencing at a point on the section line between sections 19 & 30, Township 30, Range 22---380 feet west of the dividing line between lot 4 and northeast quarter of northeast quarter of section 30, Township 30, Range 22----running thence south 1232 feet to the Territorial road known as the Kettle River Road, and that the accompanying is a correct plat of said road according to said survey.

Dated St. Paul, September 4th, 1875, N. D. Miller, Surveyor.

It is Therefore Ordered and Determined that a road be and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description aforesaid, and the report and plat accompanying which is hereby made a part of this order, and it is hereby declared to be a public highway, four rods wide, the description above given being the center of said road.
