Whereas, Upon the petition of twelve legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, with two (2) miles--of the road proposed in said petition to be opened; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk previous to the time of posting copies thereof, and copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said Town, at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit; which said proposed road is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz:

Beginning at the quarter section corner on the East side of Section 16, Township 29, Range 22, thence West on quarter section line 3100.91 ft. thence angle to left 18002' 100 ft. thence angle to left 3046' 198.7 ft. thence angle to left 305' 136.3 ft. thence angle to left 3040' 101.2 ft. thence angle to left 1020' 80.15 ft. to the center of the present travelled road in the west 20 rods of northeast quarter of southwest quarter and the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 16, Township 29, Range 22, and the Southwest quarter of said Section 16.

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: On the 18th day of October A. D. 1906 at 2 o'clock in the afternoon, at Gladstone Town Hall Causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days previous to such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant had, at least ten days previous to said time, caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway, and heard any and all reasons for or against the road the same, and being of opinion that such highway was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to open said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so described is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the quarter section corner on the east side of Section 16, Township 29, Range 22, thence west on quarter section line 3100.91 ft. thence angle to left 18°02' 100 ft. thence angle to left 3°46' 198.7 ft. thence angle to left 3°35' 136.3 ft. thence angle to left 3°40' 101.2 ft. thence angle to left 1°20' 80.15 ft. to the center to the present travelled road in the west 20 rods of northeast quarter of southwest quarter and the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 16, Township 29, Range 22, and the southwest quarter of northwest quarter of said section 16.

It Is Therefore Ordered and Determined, That a road be, and the same is hereby open and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying, which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is declared to be a public highway sixty feet wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.
