COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' ROAD ORDER

December 6, 1887

At a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of said County held August 2, 1887, a copy of the report of the Committee appointed by us at our last session to examine the road hereinafter named having been duly returned by which said report it appears, that the said committee met at the time and place designated in our order of appointment and examined the highway proposed to be located, viz:

Beginning at the quarter post between Sections 20 and 17, Township 29, Range 22, thence North on said line as near as practicable to the quarter post between Sections 8 and 5; thence West on said section line between Sections 5 and 8 to intersect the old Columbus Road or better known as the Kettle River Road; thence Westerly and Northerly on said road running into and through the Town of White Bear in said County of Ramsey. And recommended that the prayer of the petitioners for the location of said highway be granted; and a majority of the Board of County Commissioners being of the opinion that the public interest would be promoted by the location of said highway and that the location of said road would be of sufficient advantage to the county to warrant the paying of the damages hereinafter assessed,

We do hereby Order and Determine that the prayer of said petitioners be granted, and that a highway be and is hereby located according to the description above given, which is hereby declared a public highway, and the Auditor is hereby directed to notify the Supervisors of the several towns through which such highway is located that they cause so much of said highway as lies in their respective towns to be opened without delay.

We have assessed the damages sustained by reason of the location of said road to the lands over which the same passes and to the owners thereof as being equalled by the benefits thereon.
