SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

Aug. 24, 1887

Whereas, upon the petition of six legal voters owning real estate or occupying real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States or under contract from the State of Minnesota within one mile of the road proposed in said petition to be discontinued, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said Town at least Twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit which said proposed discontinuance is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz:

Beginning at a point on the Section line between Sections 23 and 14 Twenty-two (22) rods West of the $\frac{1}{4}$ Section Post between Sections 14 and 23, Town 29, Range 23 running thence North $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to East and West $\frac{1}{4}$ Section line of said Section 14, thence running East Twenty-two (22) rods to center of Section 14, and whereas upon receiving said petition we did, within Thirty days thereafter, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: on the 24th day of August A.D. 1887 at G.S. Blake's old place causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said town at least ten days previous to such meeting and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice and being satisfied that the applicant had at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway and hear any and all reasons for or against discontinuing the same and being of the opinion that such discontinuing was necessary and proper and that the public interest would be promoted thereby we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to discontinue said road, the description of which as so discontinued is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the Section line between Sections 23 and 14, Twenty-two (22) rods West of the $\frac{1}{4}$ Section Post between Sections 14 and 23, Town 29, Range 23 running thence North $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to East and West $\frac{1}{4}$ Section line of Section 14, thence running East twenty-two (22) rods to center of Section 14. It is therefore ordered and determined that a road be and the same is hereby discontinued according to the description last aforesaid.
