SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

Whereas, Upon the petition of twelve legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within two (2) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk previous to the time of posting copies thereof, and copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said Town, at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit; which said proposed new road is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz:

Beginning at Cleveland Avenue at a point being the Northeast corner of the Southeast 1/4 of Section seventeen (17) Township twenty-nine (29) Range twenty-three (23) West; thence due West on the 1/2 section line to where it intersects with Oak Street the said road to be four (4) rods wide.

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: On the 10th day of February, A.D. 1900 at the road to be laid out at 2 o'clock P.M. causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days previous to such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant had, at least ten days previous to said time, caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway, and heard any and all reasons for or against the laying out of the same, and being of opinion that such laying out was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road accompanying, the description of which as so is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at Cleveland Avenue at a point being the Northeast corner of the Southeast 1/4 of Section seventeen (17) Township twenty-nine (29) Range twenty-three (23) West; thence due West on the 1/2 section line to where it intersects with Oak Street.

It is Therefore Ordered and Determined, That a road be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying, which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is declared to be a public highway four (4) rods wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.
