DECLARATION

June 18,1928

Be it resolved that Reservoir Ave. from Lexington Ave. East to Victoria St .. being an extension of County Road "A-2" and being 66 feet in width, be, and the same is hereby constituted and declared a County Road, the same not being within the incorporated limits of any city or town.

Whereas, upon the petition of nineteen (19) legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States or under contract from the State of Minnesota within two (2) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out, which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk previous to the time of posting, copies thereof and copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said town at least twenty days before any action was held in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit which said proposed new road is set forth and described in said petition as follows: viz:

SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

Beginning on Snelling Ave. at the Northwest corner of the Northwest # of the Southwest # of Section fifteen (15), Township twenty-nine (29), Range twenty-three (23) and running East 1 mile on \frac{1}{2} section line to the Northeast corner of Northeast & of Southeast & of Section fifteen (15), Township twenty-nine (29), Range twenty-three (23), said description to be the center of said road.

And whereas, upon receiving said petition we did within thirty days thereafter make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: on the 9th day of April, at 9 o'clock in the forenoon at Town Hall causing copies of such notices to be posted in three public places in said Town and each property owner along said proposed road to be notified at least ten days previous to such meeting and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice and being satisfied that the applicants had at least ten days previous to such meeting caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the owners of land through which such highway might pass by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said owners, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway, and then heard any and all reasons for or against the laying out of said road and being of the opinion that such laying out was necessary and proper and that the public interest would be promoted, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and decided to lay out said road, the description of which is as follows, viz:

Beginning on Snelling Ave. at the Northeast corner of the Northwest & of the Southwest & of Section fifteen (15), Township twenty-nine (29), Range twenty-three (23) and running East 1 mile on \frac{1}{2} section line to the Northeast corner of Northeast & of Southeast & of Section fifteen (15). Township twenty-nine (29), Range twenty-three (23). Said description to be the center of the road. It is therefore ordered and determined that a road be and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description last aforesaid and it is declared to be a public highway four (4) rods wide.
