SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

June 30, 1873

Feb. 6, 1922

Commissioner Farrell made a motion, seconded Freeman that the town road running South of McCarron Lake in Section 13, Town 29, Range 23 from Rice Street West to Newell Street be constituted and declared a county road, the same being outside the corporate limits of any incorporated city or village and same carried by the following vote: Ayes: Churchill, Farrell, Freeman, Keller, Carr and Lind. Nays: None.

WHEREAS, upon the petition in writing of six legal voters residing within one mile of the route hereinafter described for a public highway, a copy of their petition having been first duly posted and due notice having been given as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said Town, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against laying out the same and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of said meeting and having heard such as were offered for or against the laying out of said road and having personally examined the route proposed in said petition for a road, on the 10th day of April, 1878, viz: Commencing at a point about six rods West of the Southwest Corner of the Northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, said Town, on the County Road running from Como Avenue to Mounds View, thence East on East and West $\frac{1}{4}$ Section line in said Section 13 and in Section 14 about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile; thence in a southeasterly direction to the County Road on the Township line between the Towns of Rose and New Canada, and being of the opinion that such laying out is necessary and proper and that the public interest would be promoted thereby and having granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road we did on the 21st day of April 1873 cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor who made report to us as follows:

I hereby certify that the accompanying diagram represents the plat and field notes of a road petition per by certain Freeholders of Rose Township, Ramsey County, Minnesota; Commencing at a point on the County Road leading from Como Avenue to Mounds View six rods West of the $\frac{1}{4}$ Post between Sections 13 and 14, Town. 29, Range 23, thence East on centre line of said Sections about $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile, then in a Southeasterly direction to the County Road on the line between the Towns of Rose and New Canada, and surveyed as per order of Supervisors of Rose Township."

It is therefore endorsed and determined that a road be and the same is hereby laid out and established according to said survey and plat herewith annexed and made part of this Order, which is hereby declared to be a public highway, four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said road.
