### DECLARATION

Commissioner Nash presented the following resolution:

By Commissioner Nash:

RESOLVED, That the following public highways in the towns of Rose and Mounds View, Ramsey County, Minnesota, outside of the corporate limits of any incorporated city or village in said county, be and the same are hereby constituted and declared to be county roads in said Ramsey County, to-wit:

Fairchild Avenue, so called, from Lexington Avenue East to Victoria Street (also known as St. Paul, Bass Lake and Mounds View Road),

Victoria Street from Fairchild Avenue to Lake Owasso Boulevard,

Lake Owasso Boulevard (formerly known as the Lake Emily Road) as described in Dedication Agreement dated September 2, 1913, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Ramsey County, Minnesota, in Book 69 of Miscellaneous Records on pages 104-106, and widened as provided in supplemental dedication dated June 24, 1914, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Ramsey County, Minnesota, in Book 68 of Miscellaneous Records on Page 141 .

On motion of Nash, seconded Farrell, same was adopted by the following vote: Ayes: Bures, Farrell, Lind, Miesen and Nash. Nays; None.

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' ROAD ORDER

March 10, 1876

STATE OF MINNESOTA )  
COUNTY OF RAMSEY ) SS

At a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of said County, held March 4, 1876, the report of the Committee appointed by us at our last session to examine the road hereinafter named, have reported that they met at the time and place designated in our order of appointment and examined the highway proposed to be relocated, viz:

Beginning at the southwest corner of section 25, Cottage Homes, in the Town of Rose, running from thence north on the section line between sections 23, 24, 13 and 14 and as near as practicable between sections 11 and 12, thence west on half section line half mile, thence north on half section line as near as practicable through the town of Rose to the town line of Mounds View, thence north on the quarter section line of sections 35 and 26 or near the center of section 23, to the bridge, from thence north to a tree, from thence west to the section line, from thence north on the section line between sections 22 and 23, to the intersection of the Manomin road in the town of Mounds View, And recommend that the prayer of the petitions for said highway be granted:

It is therefore ordered and determined that the prayer of the petitioners be granted, and that a highway be, and is hereby relocated according to the description above given, which is hereby declared to be a public highway, and the Auditor is hereby directed to notify the supervisors of the several towns through which such road is relocated that they cause so much of said highway as lies in their respective towns to be opened without delay.
