At a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of said County, held April 4th, 1910, a copy of the report of the committee appointed by us at our last session to examine the road hereinafter named, having been duly returned, by which said report it appears that the said committee met at the time and place designated in our order of appointment and examined the highway proposed to be changed, viz:

Beginning at the Centerville Road running Northerly through the towns of New Canada and White Bear.

And your petitioners pray that you will change all that portion of said above described highway which runs as follows:

Beginning at the center of Section nine (9), Township thirty (30), Range twenty-two (22)

And running thence East along the East and West quarter line, a distance of 892 feet to the center of the present road; measured along the said quarter section line; thence with an angle to the left of 85°15' N. 4°45' E. a distance of 1157 ft., thence N. 2°25' E. a distance of 800 ft.; thence N. 4°51' E. a distance of 1000 ft., thence N. 13°13' E., a distance of 580 ft., thence N. 3°29' E. a distance of 720 ft., thence N. 13°15' W., a distance of 700 ft. thence N. 5°25' W. a distance of 400 ft., thence N. 18°25' W. a distance of 700 ft., thence N. 24°10' W. a distance

of 2000 ft., thence N. 13000' W., a distance of 548 ft.

And terminating at the intersection of the present road with the North and South center line of Section four (4) Township thirty (30), Range twenty-two (22).

And not connected with other roads as follows: The Old Centerville Road running to the villages of Centerville and Forest Lake.

So that the same when changed will run as follows:

Beginning at the center of Section nine (9), Township thirty (30), Range twenty-two (22)

And running thence North through the center of Sections nine (9) and four (4), Township thirty (30), Range

And terminating at its intersection with the center line of the present Centerville Road, same being 356.2 ft. distant from the 1/4 corner on the North line of said Section four (4) measured South along the said center line of Section four (4) and to be four (4) rods in width.

And to be connected with other roads as follows:

The Old Centerville Road running to the villages of Centerville and Forest Lake.

And recommended that the prayer of the petitioners for the change of said highway be granted; and a majority of the Board of County Commissioners being of the opinion that the public interest would be promoted by the change of said highway and that the change of said road would be sufficient advantage to the County to warrant the paying of the damages hereinafter assessed, we do hereby order and determine that the prayer of said petitioners be granted, and that a highway be and is hereby changed according to the description above given, which is hereby declared to be a public highway, and the Auditor is hereby directed to notify the Supervisors of the several towns through which such highway is changed, that they cause so much of said highway as lies in their respective towns to be opened without delay.

We have assessed the damages sustained by reason of the change of said road to the lands over which the same passes and to the owners thereof, as follows:

Alfred Charest \$25.00 Felix Labore \$40.00

And that the County open a roadway on Section line between Sections nine (9) and four (4) and also a roadway on South line of White Bear Acre Lots in Section four (4). Roads to be two (2) rods wide.
