It is Therefore Ordered and Determined that said changes and variations be made and legalized according to said survey and plat thereto annexed and made part of the order, and the same is hereby declared to be a public highway four (4) rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said road.

In Witness Whereof, We, the said Committee on Roads and Bridges, County Commissioners of Ramsey County, set our hands this 4th day of September, A.D. 1875.

\* Road Order dated and adopted Sept. 4th, 1875, no record of filing for road covering the above described land. A further search made of the records does not reveal the names of the petitioners or that service of persons interested was made according to law.

The above road order dated Sept. 4, 1875 extended from a point on the South shore of Bald Eagle Lake between the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 11, Township 30, Range 22, thence running S'y through Sections 14, 23, 27 34 to section corner between Sections 4 and 3, Township 29, Range 22, continuing S'y and SW'y to a point in the Little Canada Road and center of Section 20 in Little Canada Township.

We therefore establish the present County Road #25 or Schuneman Road a present existing county road from a point in the Otter Lake Road about 400 feet more or less in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 22, Township 30, Range 22 running in a SW'y direction through Sections 22 and 27 on the West side of the Northern Pacific R.R. to the South line of Section 27, there terminating.
