SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

September 13, 1872 66 feet wide

RAMSEY COUNTY TOWN OF WHITE BEAR SS.

Whereas, upon the petition in writing of Felix Laborre, Felix Petuzuzm, Mitchell Tardiff, Endras Auges, Joseph Auges, E. O. Rene, and Paul LaBorre, seven legal voters, residing within one mile of the road hereinafter described, (of which is prayed for in said petition) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said town, did on the 6th day of July, A. D., 1872, personally examine the route proposed in said petition for a road to-wit: Commencing at the town road that runs East and West on Section line between sections 25 and 36, thence north on quarter section line of sections 25 and 2½ to White Bear Lake on said quarter line and having, before determining to lay out said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the lying out of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such laying out of said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out the said road, we did, on the 5th day of August, A. D. 1872, cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor, who made report to us, as follows, to-wit: To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of Ramsey and State of Minnesota:

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a Road. Beginning at the quarter corner post on the South boundary of Section twenty-five (25), thence north along the quarter section of said section 25 to section twenty-four (24), thence north along the quarter section line of said section twenty-four (24) to the South shore of White Bear Lake, and would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your direction, to-wit:

And that below is a correct plat of said road, according to said survey.

John I. Halstead, Surveyor

Dated at St. Paul this 10th day of August, 1872, Township 30, Range 22 of Principal Meridian.

It is, therefore, ordered and determined that said road be and is hereby laid out and established according to said survey, and the plat hereunto annexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be a public highway four (4) rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said Road.

In witness whereof, we, the said supervisors, have hereunto set our hands, this 13th day of September, A.D.1872.
