Nov. 4, 1895

By Commissioner Wright:

Resolved that the road known as the Town line road, between the towns of New Canada and White Bear running West from the County line of Washington and Ramsey Counties until it intersects with the County road known as Labore road be, and is hereby accepted and adopted as a County Road.

SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

Whereas, upon the petition of twenty-eight legal voters, who own real estate, or who occupy real estate under the Homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within one (1) mile of the road proposed in said petition to be located, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said Town, at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit; which said proposed road is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz:

Beginning at a point on the County line between the Counties of Ramsey and Washington, where Township line of Townships of White Bear and New Canada intersects said County line; thence west along said Township line of White Bear and New Canada, or as near said Township line as practicable, to where the County Road, known as the St. Paul and Centerville Road in Sections thirty-three (33) and thirty-four (34) cross said Township line.

And Whereas, upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: On the 10th day of April A. D. 1883, at August Radatz house (adjourned until 13th day of April A. D. 1883, at same place, causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town at least ten days previous to such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant had, at least ten days previous to said time, caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway, and heard any and all reasons for or against laying out the same, and being of the opinion that such highway was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out said road and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying the description of which as so laid out is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning on the Town line between the Towns of White Bear and New Canada, intersects the East line of Ramsey County Minnesota; thence west, along said Town line to the center of the Centerville Road, 10.26 chains west of the quarter section corner between sections four (4) Township twenty-nine (29) Range twenty-two (22) west and Section thirty-three (33) Township thirty (30) North Range twenty-two (22) west.

The total length of the road being 3 628/1000 miles.

It is Therefore Ordered and Determined, that a road be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying, which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is hereby declared to be a public highway four (4) rods wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.
