

On job to spot culverts for Messer conc. products Co. "Bob" Moore on job in afternoon; said his outfit would start clearing brush following Monday and probably start grading following Wednesday.

Ton Tony Tkibe regarding removal of fence on & 2<sup>nd</sup> 1/2 mile. Said he would remove it tomorrow or Monday.

Saturday April 15

Part of Moore's camp and equipment moving in today. Bob Moore agreed to haul away rubbish from between Ita 48 & J2 Fort \$8.00. Nothing doing along grade by Moore's Tkibe moving fence on & today.

Tues. Apr. 18


Clearing brush

Enough to keep pipe above present water level (2' above toe of slope) Would use two 3" x 10" x 16' plank with 3" x 10" x 3' @ 3' intervals transverse. Use 24' of 3" x 10" 1 width for remainder of pipe to So. using transverser pieces as above. Rubble the slope at outlet.

Met representative of tel co on job regarding

pole to be moved at end of proj. His crew will move it the first thing Monday morning. Left job early went to shop to test trap rock from Feyen's plant.

Tuesday Apr. 22

Talked Bob Moore about planking culv at \$70 15<sup>75</sup>. He is going to get a price on 130 lin ft and also on 334 1/4 lin ft of 3x10" because I am certain that plank will also be necessary at \$70 21<sup>75</sup> for 36" P3.

More of the outfit moved onto the job last night 6, mules and 2, skinners

Talk farmer at end of job about removing bin filled with grain that is in line of ditch let at \$70 48<sup>50</sup>. He hasn't time to move it before

Sunday April 23

Crew working

on West end of job in AM  
with slips. Started work  
with elevating grader in  
afternoon at East end.

Took Bob Moore to former  
North of Cord "G" & Inelling  
to see if plank he has  
piled in back of barn  
would be suitable for  
culvert cradle. Planks  
are not new, but are in  
very good condition.

Agreed to a price of  
\$35.00 for material at  
culv. site and enough to  
plank the culverts at  
Sta 15+00 & 21+75  
134 lin ft 3x10" at Sta 15+00  
225 " " 3x10" " " 21+75

Tuesday Apr 25


I spent most of day  
with crews on force  
acct putting in pipes at  
site 15+00 and 21+75.  
Work is in water and  
difficult. Grading is  
going fine. Bob Moore

Cloudy - cool

thinks he is ready for  
blue tops but Thursday  
is plenty soon enough  
will get him to put  
more shape to grade  
tomorrow. Contractor  
built drive to left at  
Sta 50+00 with absolutely  
no order from me.  
If "Van" OK's it we'll  
leave it otherwise I'll  
get it out quick.

Wed. Apr 24.

Watched installation  
of 36" P-3 at Sta 21+75.  
Work went along fine until  
Bob started pushing, then  
the crew dropped a pipe  
from top of ditch onto  
pipe breaking planks  
and throwing remaining  
planks off line and grade.  
Had them remove pipe  
and put in new plank  
to line and grade, at



no added force acc't on  
material charge to us.

There has been no  
blading done as yet  
and the ditches are not  
sufficiently excavated  
to justify our putting  
in blue tops before  
Friday. (on 2<sup>nd</sup> &  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile)

Wolfsangle on job late  
in afternoon and agrees  
with me regarding blue  
tops.

Thursday Apr 27.

Started blading  
last night after dinner  
but broke down before  
anything material done.  
Van out in P.M. Will send  
crew for blue tops in  
morning to get them  
providing road is blocked.  
Back slopes on 2<sup>nd</sup>  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  mile are now in good  
shape. Entrance that

for cultivation) and one  
driveway would be  
insufficient. Its 10+00 Rt.

25+50 and 30+00 are not  
necessary. J Kibbe says that  
affected property has not  
been cultivated or taxes  
paid on it for 15 yrs.

Jurvey party out in after-  
noon. partially blue topped

hell because they didn't  
work over-time and finish.  
Jobs were all a bunch  
of God damn ~~pissed~~  
tractor broke down at  
2:30. Worked in ditches  
with 4 teams and slips  
rest of day

Tue Apr 29

Jurvey party  
finished blue tops  
on ~~good~~ <sup>3</sup>/4 mi this  
morning. grade is rough  
but doesn't vary so much  
as far as elev is  
concerned. Will require

a great deal of slip work in ditches and finishing. Couldn't find Farmer at end of job Lt. regarding placing his two driveways. Rained at 4 PM and had to quit. Bob Moore says he is going to work tomorrow (Sunday) again. Noticed today that culvert at 0-40 is beginning to sag in middle. If weight of rest of fill drops it anymore it will have to come out and be planted.

Sunday Apr. 30

Elevating grader not working today. Crew finishing with teams and slips. tried again, both in town and on job, to find Farmer at end of job

regarding location of his  
drives - no luck.

Monday April, 1

All slip work today  
rained hard here last  
night. So whole crew is  
on finishing. Bob Moore's  
presence while finishing  
would make a nice looking  
job impossible, until  
about the fourth time  
over. Tow Farmer at  
end of job today about  
drives. Still insists  
he needs extra drive at  
S10 50<sup>00</sup> & so got no  
satisfaction as to prefer-  
ence between it and  
drive at S10 51<sup>00</sup> Lt  
51<sup>00</sup> is the logical  
practical & efficient  
place for one, also at  
that pt it requires no  
cutting.

Cloudy - cold

Tues. May 2

Elevating grader working today. If it doesn't rain again tonight will probably finish with it tomorrow. Bob Moore still thinks he is short of dirt. Shrinkage is running high but some of his shoulders are running high and far. (From 15+00 to 21+00) He wants blue tops on 1st 1/2 mi tomorrow but that section is far too rough - still in slope stake stage. Wolfgang on job at 3:30.

I waited 2 hours for truck hauling C&I culverts to show driver where to dump them. He was to be at E. end job shortly after lunch. When I was on way home at 5:30 truck passed me on Anoka

Wed. May 3

Beginning to look as if we might be short of dirt. Can tell definitely tomorrow. Moore quit at 4:30. Stock was half dead from long haul.

Thursday May 4

Survey party out setting blue tops all day on 1st 1/3 mile.

Van out in afternoon lowered grade 0.3 from 0 to 10+00 to 22+00. In event this change is not sufficient to balance he approves of widening ditch on left to 38 ft from 18 3+00 to 6+00. Tony Skiba doesn't want driveway to his land on



Everything going as

I arrived on job. Then  
I ordered him to complete  
the cut from Jta 3+00  
to 6+00. There is no  
doubt regarding our  
needing the dirt - we  
need it. The whole job  
is full of high and low  
spots so Bob had his  
crow and mucker



going up and down the  
grade until about 3:30  
I think he got disgusted  
with his own work and  
pulled the machine in,  
in favor of slips. I  
sure can see why Bill W.  
used to get nuts with  
this god damn outfit.  
this Bob Moore is the  
original horses ass of  
a damn poor horse.

Blade went to hell at  
noon - wheels fell off.  
they try to blade and  
finish with trees and  
stumps lying all over  
the job.

On extra excavation  
this morning there was  
no overhead.




