Award of Damages

STATE OF MINNESOTA) COUNTY OF RAMSEY) SS TOWN OF WHITE BEAR)

Whereas, a road was laid out on the fifth day of November A.D. 1894, by us, the Supervisors of said Town of White Bear on the petition of fourteen legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emotion laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within two (2) miles of said road, which said road which was laid out, is set forth and described in the foregoing Supervisors order, made by us, and,

Whereas, a part of the damages sustained by reason of the laying out said road has been ascertained by the agreement of the owners of the lands through which said road passes, with us, and a part of the owners of the said lands have in writing released all claims to damages; but not being able to agree with the owners of the following described lands, claiming damages by reason of said highway passing through, and the owners of some of the said lands being unknown, we have assessed the damages to each of such individual claimants with whom we could not agree, and awarded damages to the owners of such lands through which such highway passes as are unknown, at what we deemed just and right; taking into account and estimating the advantages and benefits the road will confer on the claimants and owners, as well as the disadvantages. We have assessed and awarded damages as follows:

Owners of Lands Desc. of Lands Sec. Twp. Range Damages

To Mrs. Sarah Millner and to the owners of Lots in the platted sites of Millners Lake Addition to Bald Eagle and the Townsite of Bald Eagle, one hundred (\$100.00) dollars.

And in the case of the following lands and claimants for damages, we estimate that the advantages and benefits said road will confer on them are equal to all damages sustained by them by reason of laying out said road to-wit:

Cwners of Lands Desc. of Lands Sec. Twn. Range

To Mrs. Sarah Milner and to the owners of Lots in the platted sites of Milners Lake Addition to Bald Eagle and the Townsite of Bald Eagle, ninety nine dollars and ninety five cents (\$99.95)
