Whereas, upon the Petition, in writing, of Daniel R. Ivett, Edward Tart, J. E. Extrand, C. F. Strom, R. H. Long, W. H. Kelsey, M. J. Tart, Julia Tatro, L. D. Michaud, L. C. Wood, M. W. Erhardt, Theo. Hansen, Thos. C. Fulton, F. F. Farrar, S. T. Hall, V. C. Smith, Harry Freeman, E. A. Bacon, F. G. Campbell, eighteen legal voters, residing within two miles of the road hereinafter described (the laying out of which is prayed for in said petition), a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Village Council of White Bear Village and the Supervisors of said town, did, on the 15th day of October A.D. 1907, examine the road proposed in said petition _____ to-wit:

Beginning at the S.E. 1/4 of the N. 1/2 of the N.W. 1/4 of Section 14, Town 30, Range 22, thence West along the quarter quarter section line to the S.W. corner of the said N. 1/2 of the N.W. 1/4 of Section 14.

And having, before determining to lay out said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the laying _____ of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such laying out of said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out the said road, we did, on the _____ day of _____ A.D. 18____ cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor, who made report to us as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of _____ in the County of _____ and State of Minnesota:

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a road beginning at _____ would report that the following is a correct survey thereof, as made by me under your directions, to-wit: _____

It is, Therefore, Ordered and Determined that the said road be and is hereby laid out and established according to said survey, and the plat hereunto annexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be a public highway, four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said road.
