WHEREAS, Upon the petition of six legal voters owning real estate within one mile of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said town at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto; which said proposed new road is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz:

AND WHEREAS, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon said application, to-wit: on the 22nd day of June A.D. 1878 at the Railroad Bridge on Section 32 in said town, causing copies of such notice to be posted up in three public places in said town at least ten days previous to such meeting, and having met at such time and place as above mamed in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant had at least ten days previous to said time caused such notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which said highway might pass, by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway and heard any and all reasons for or against laying out the same, and being of the opinion that such laying out was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road, the description of which is as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point on the Township line North 3.44 chains from the Northwest corner of the Southwest *corner of Section 15 of said town, running thence due East 13 chains, thence South 64½ degrees East 3.2 chains, thence South 74½ degrees East 5 chains, thence South 54½ degrees East 2 chains, thence North 51, degrees East 4

* Corner should read quarter. This was determined by running the legal description backwards.
