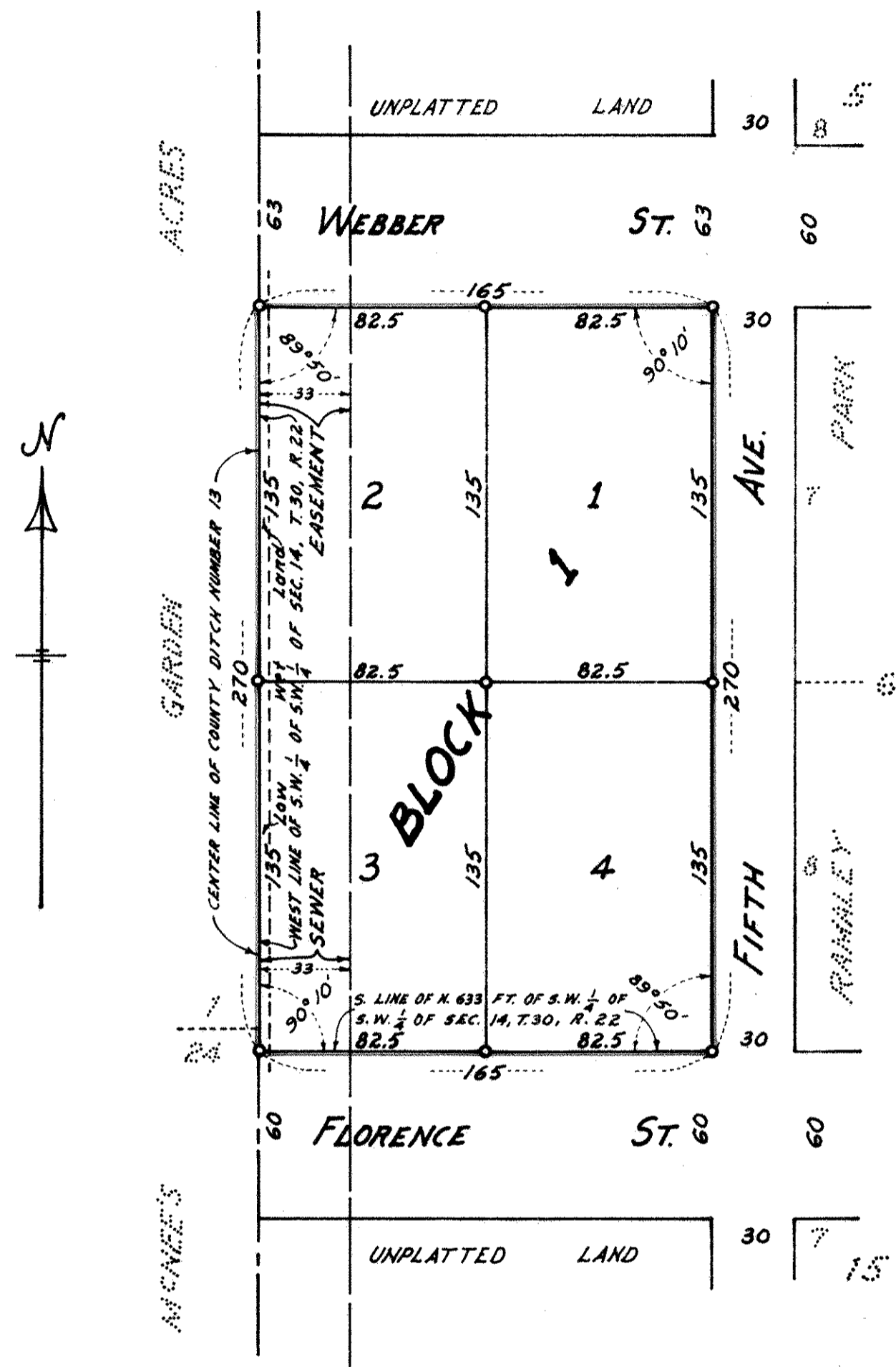


COPY NAP DUPRE'S ADDITION
