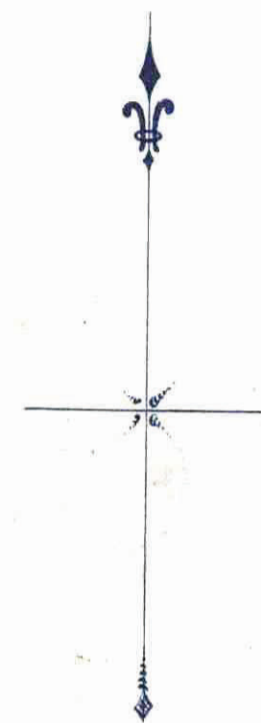

We the undersigned hereby acknowledge that we did on November 1855 cause to be surveyed and marked into lots, all that piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Ramsey and Territory of Minnesota, being in Section No. 36, Township No. 29 North of Range 23 west of the fourth principal meridian, viz. Commencing at the north west corner of the north east quarter of the south east quarter of section No. 36, Township No. 29, Range 23 west, from thence running west, six rods to the East line of land belonging M. C. Taylor and then north along said line seven chains and fifty links thence west and at right angles with said line five chains, thence north and at right angles with said line two chains and fifty links, thence in a north westerly direction four chains and fifty links, thence running North eleven degrees East seven chains and fifty links, thence East and at right angles with said last line, eleven chains and seventy five links, thence South, eleven degrees West at right angles with said last line twenty chains to the place of beginning, containing two acres of land more or less, Also the west one half of the South East quarter of the North East quarter of section No. 36 in Township No. 29, North of Range No. 23 west, containing 20, twenty acres of land. As an Addition to the City of Saint Paul.
