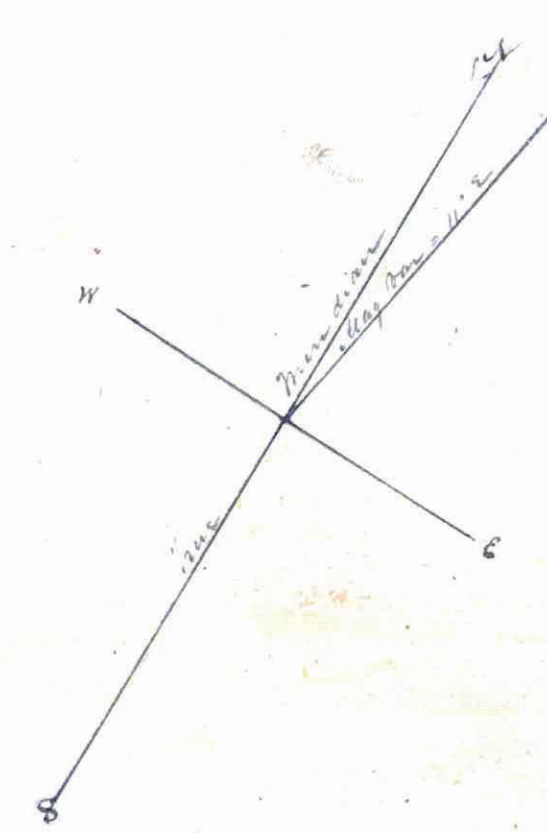


FARINGTON and KINNEY'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL

I do hereby certify that this is a correct plat of Farington & Kinney's addition to the City of St. Paul, said addition being in the 1/2 of the 31 1/2 of Section thirty one of Township twenty nine North, of Range twenty two West of the 4th prin. Mer. is bounded as follows: viz. beginning at a point on Eleventh Street at the Eastern corner of land owned by James D. Breck, thence running North 48° + 30' West, 217 feet and then to the North corner of said Breck's land, thence South 57° + 45' West 210 1/3 feet, thence North 48° + 30' West 208 1/4 feet, thence North 53° + 45' East 613 1/2 feet to line of land owned by J. C. Whiskey, thence South 41° + 35' East 626 1/4 feet to Eleventh Street aforesaid, thence South 57° + 45' West 138 feet to the point of beginning
