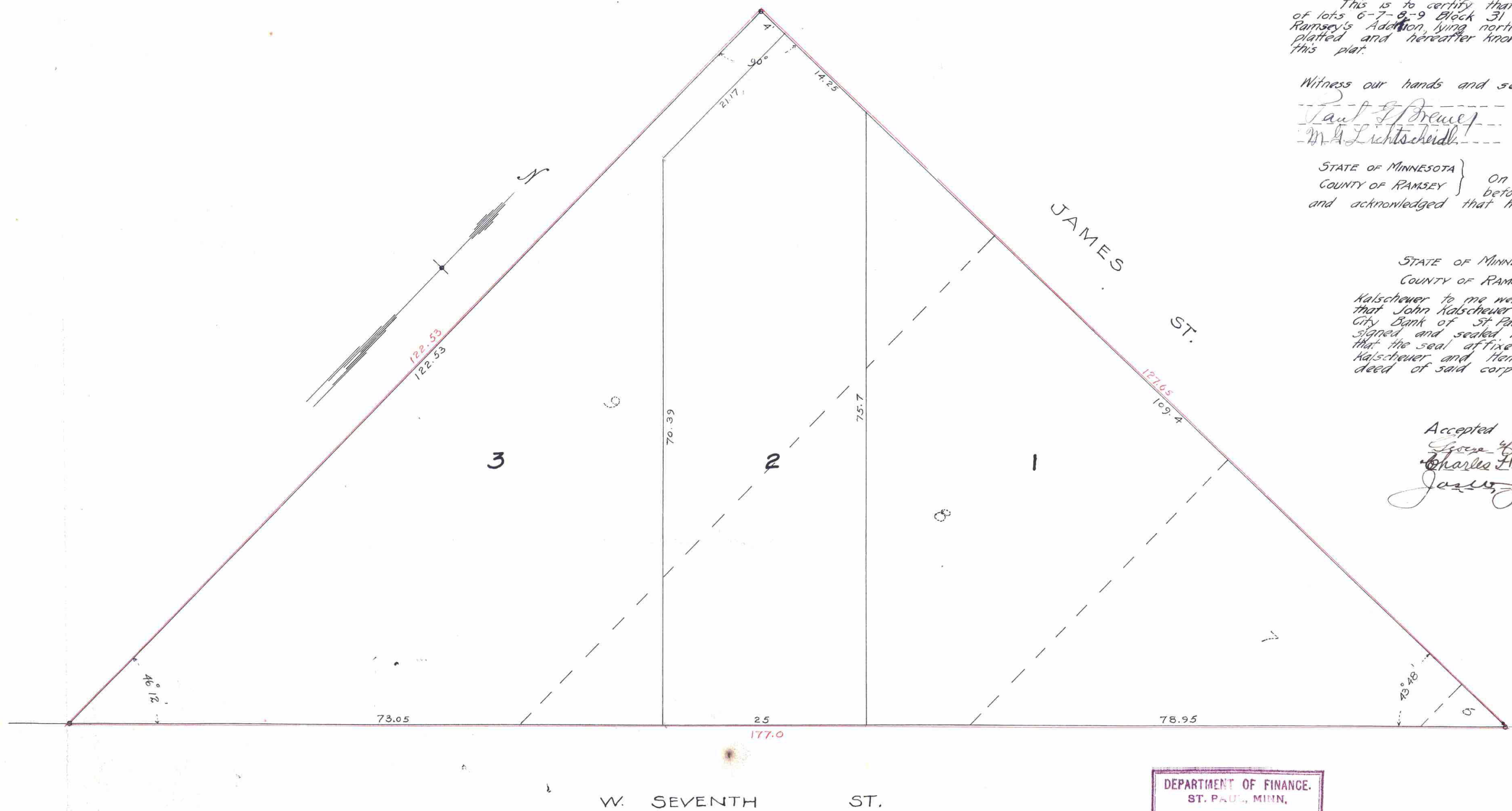


CITY BANK REARRANGEMENT.
