I, Gates A. Johnson do hereby certify that at the request of the proprietors Roscoe F. Hersey and Eva C. Hersey his wife; and Edward L. Hersey and Mary L. Hersey his wife, I made a survey of all that part of the West half of the South East 1/4 of Section 27 Town 29 Range 23 that lies south of the St. Paul Minneapolis & Manitoba Short Line Railway except 2 7/80 acres belonging to Harriet E. Shelden in the County of Ramsey Minnesota, into Lots, Blocks and Streets, in the proportion of the measurements on this plat indicated, the Scale thereof being 100 Feet to 1 Inch, and have designated said plat as Hersey-Woolsey Addition, and I have set a monument 30 feet east and 33 feet south of the southeast corner of Block 13, also a monument 30 feet west and 33 feet south of the south west corner of Block 12, as starting points and guidance for future surveys.
