Beginning at an iron monument on the south line of said lot, distant 33 feet East from the Southwest corner thereof, thence North on a line parallel with the west line of said lot, 24 feet to a point, thence East on a line parallel with the south line of said lot 532.80 feet to a point, thence N. 3° 29' E. 232.11 feet to a point of curve, thence on a curve to right, Radius 680.94 feet, Angle 18° 40', Chord 220.87 feet to end of curve, thence on tangent 597.01 feet to a point, thence East on a line parallel with the south line of said lot, 381.41 feet more or less to the margin of Turtle Lake, thence southerly on the margin of said lake 1130 feet more or less to the south line of aforesaid Government Lot, thence West on the South line of said lot 250.20 feet more or less to an iron monument, distant 555.40 feet East from the point of beginning, thence West on the South line of said lot 555.40 feet to the point of beginning.
