





OWNERS CERTIFICATE.

This is to certify that Northern States Power Company, a corporation, organized under the laws of the State of Minnesota, owner, and Guaranty Trust Company of New York, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York, Trustee, and Charles H. Platner, South Orange, New Jersey, co-trustee, and Harris Trust and Savings Bank, a corporation, organized under the laws of the State of Illinois, and Murdoch H.
