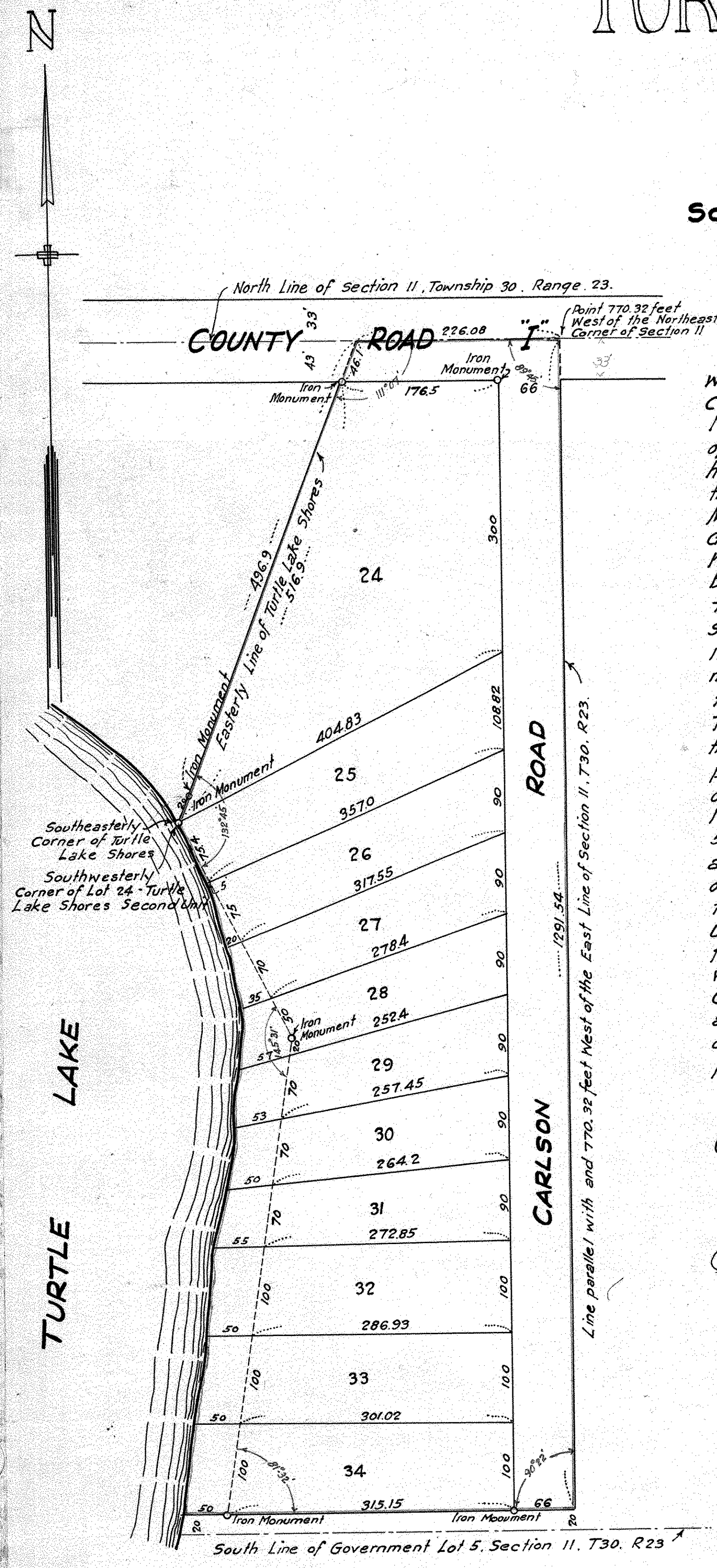


TURTLE LAKE SHORES

This is to certify that Aaron Carlson and Minnie Carlson, his wife, owners and proprietors, Midland National Bank and Trust Company of Minneapolis, a corporation, (formerly The Midland National Bank of Minneapolis), trustee under mortgage deed of trust, and Maud Gould Perry and Clarence G. Perry, her husband, purchasers of part under Contract for Deed, of the following described property situate in the state of Minnesota and County of Ramsey to wit: All that part of Government Lot 5, Section 11, Township 30 North, Range 23 West of the Fourth Principal Meridian described as follows: Beginning at a point in the North line of said Section 11 distant 770.32 feet West of the Northeast corner of said Section; thence South parallel with the East line of said Section 11, a distance of 1291.54 feet to a point 20 feet North of the South line of Government Lot 5 in said Section 11; thence West parallel with the South line of said Government Lot 5 to the shore of Turtle Lake; thence Northerly along the shore of said Lake to the Southeast corner of Turtle Lake Shores according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Ramsey County, Minnesota; thence Northeasterly along the Easterly line of said Turtle Lake shores 563 feet to the North line of aforesaid Section 11; thence East along the North line of said Section 11, 226.08 feet to the point of beginning. Have caused the same to be surveyed and plotted and to be hereafter known as "TURTLE LAKE SHORES SECOND UNIT" as shown by this plat, and hereby dedicate to the public for public use forever, the roads as shown on said plat.
