



**RE-ARRANGEMENT

Whereas an error or discrepancy in the dimensions of all those lots in Block Sixty two (62) of Irvine's Enlargement of Rice and Irvine's Addition to St Paul according to the recorded plat thereof on file in the office of the Register of Deeds, Ramsey County, Minnesota, lying and being between the alley in said Block and West Third and West Fifth Street in the City of Saint Paul, County of Ramsey and State of Minnesota appears upon the recorded plat aforesaid making it impossible to determine with certainty the lines of said lots in said Block of said Addition. - Now therefore to the end that the lines governing the respective interests of the several owners of said lots in said Block may be definitely fixed and forever settled. - We the said owners of said lots in said Block, - excepting and reserving herefrom the following described premises to wit: Commencing where the southerly line of Pleasant Avenue intersects the northwesterly line of the alley in said Block; thence southerly along last named line ninety (90) feet; thence southwesterly parallel to the eastwesterly line of said alley ninety (90) feet to the aforesaid line of Pleasant Avenue; thence northeasterly along last named line forty (40) feet to the point of beginning, have caused the same to be surveyed and platted anew and to be hereafter known as Re-arrangement of part of Block Sixty two (62) of Irvine's Enlargement to Rice and Irvine's Addition to Saint Paul as herein designated, and we hereby agree that the lines, measurements and dimensions as shown by this plat are true and correct, and that George W. Reece and Ella Reece his wife are the owners of Lot 1. - that Lizzie Montgomery is the owner of Lot 2. - that Cecelia E. Otis and Arthur G. Otis her husband are the owners of Lot 3. - that William P. Bockey is the owner of Lot 4. - that Frank H. Peyer and Anna J. Peyer his wife are the owners of Lot 5. - that The St Paul Trust Company as the executor and Trustee of Robert N. McLaren deceased, Archibald McLaren and Anna M. McLaren widow of said Robert N. McLaren deceased are the owners of Lot 6. all the above described lots being designated according to said new survey and plat, and we do acknowledge that we execute the said new plat as our own free act and deed.
