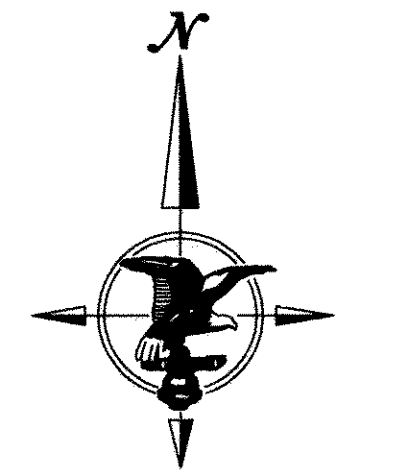
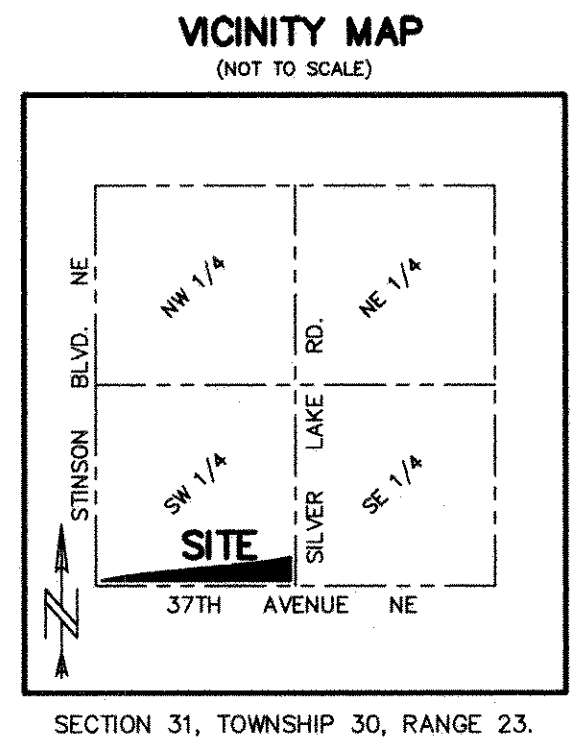
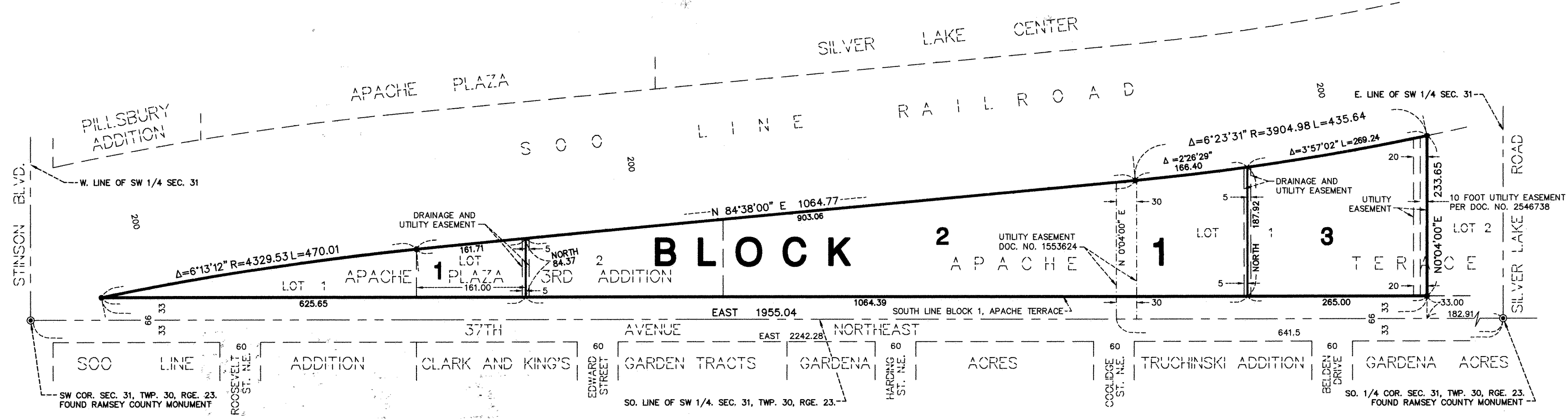


APACHE TERRACE 2ND ADDITION
