 River, on land from 50 to 80 feet above the River. It is 7 miles from
 the falls of St. Anthony & 7 from St. Snelling & is at the head
 of good Steamboat navigation. Its geographical position & rapid
 settlement must inevitably draw to it the Seat of Government
 of the Territory of Minnesota.
