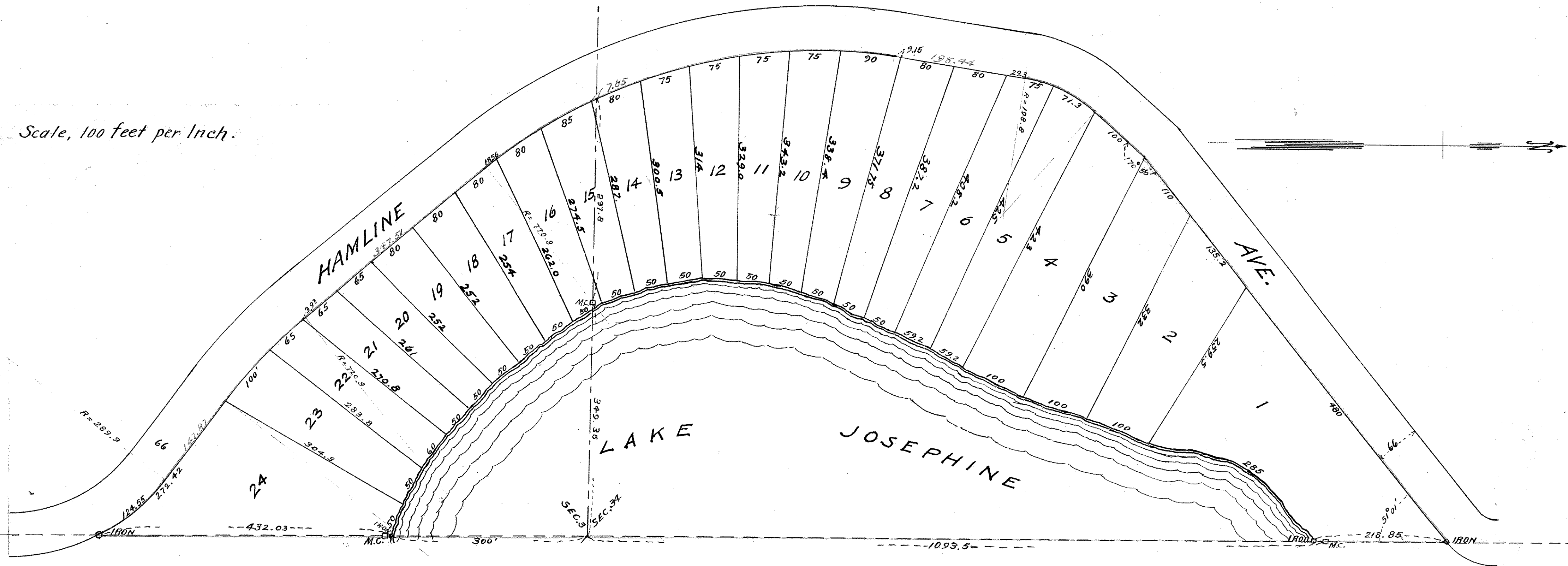


# HACKNEY PARK
