

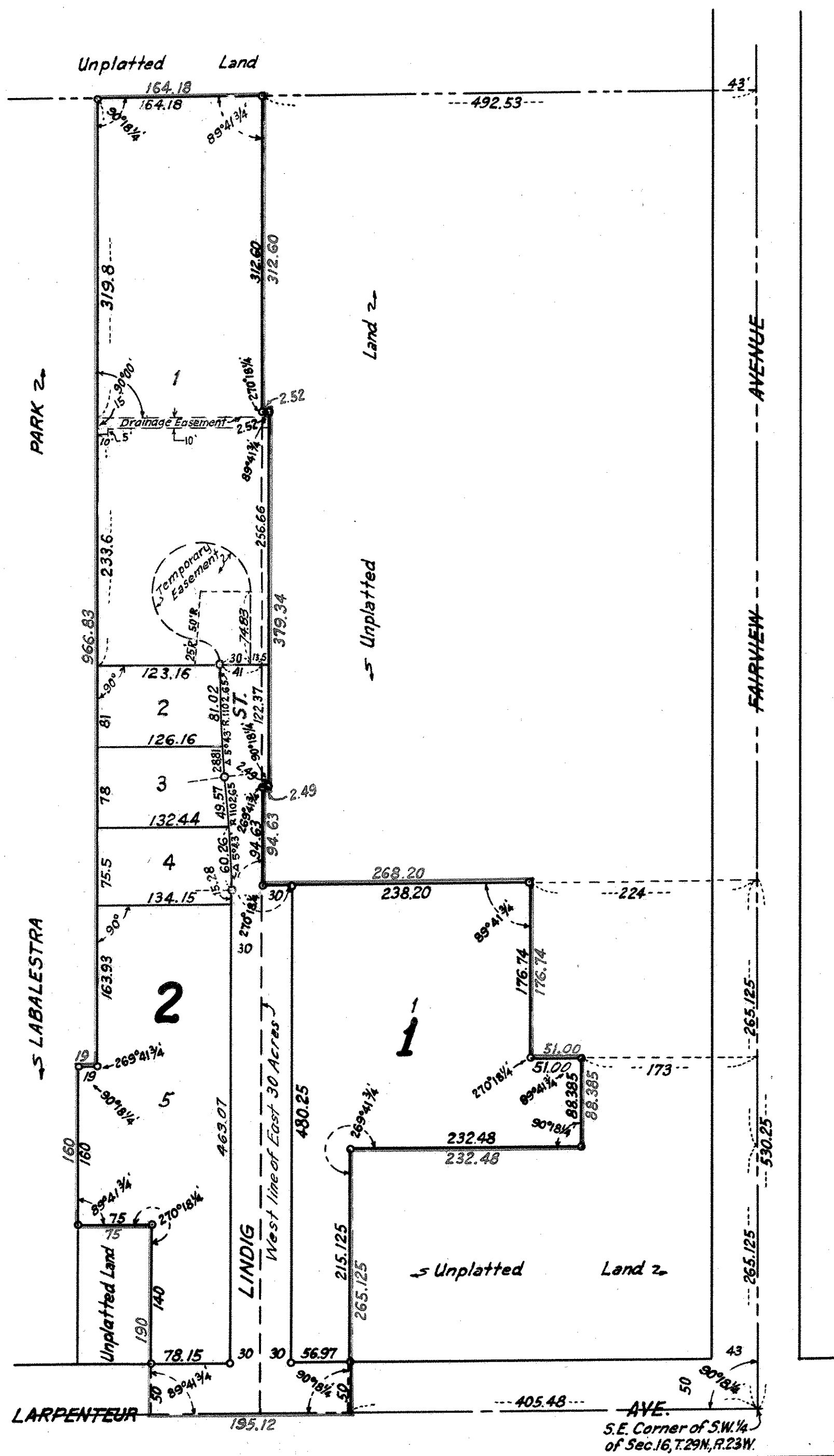
# LINDIG ADDITION
