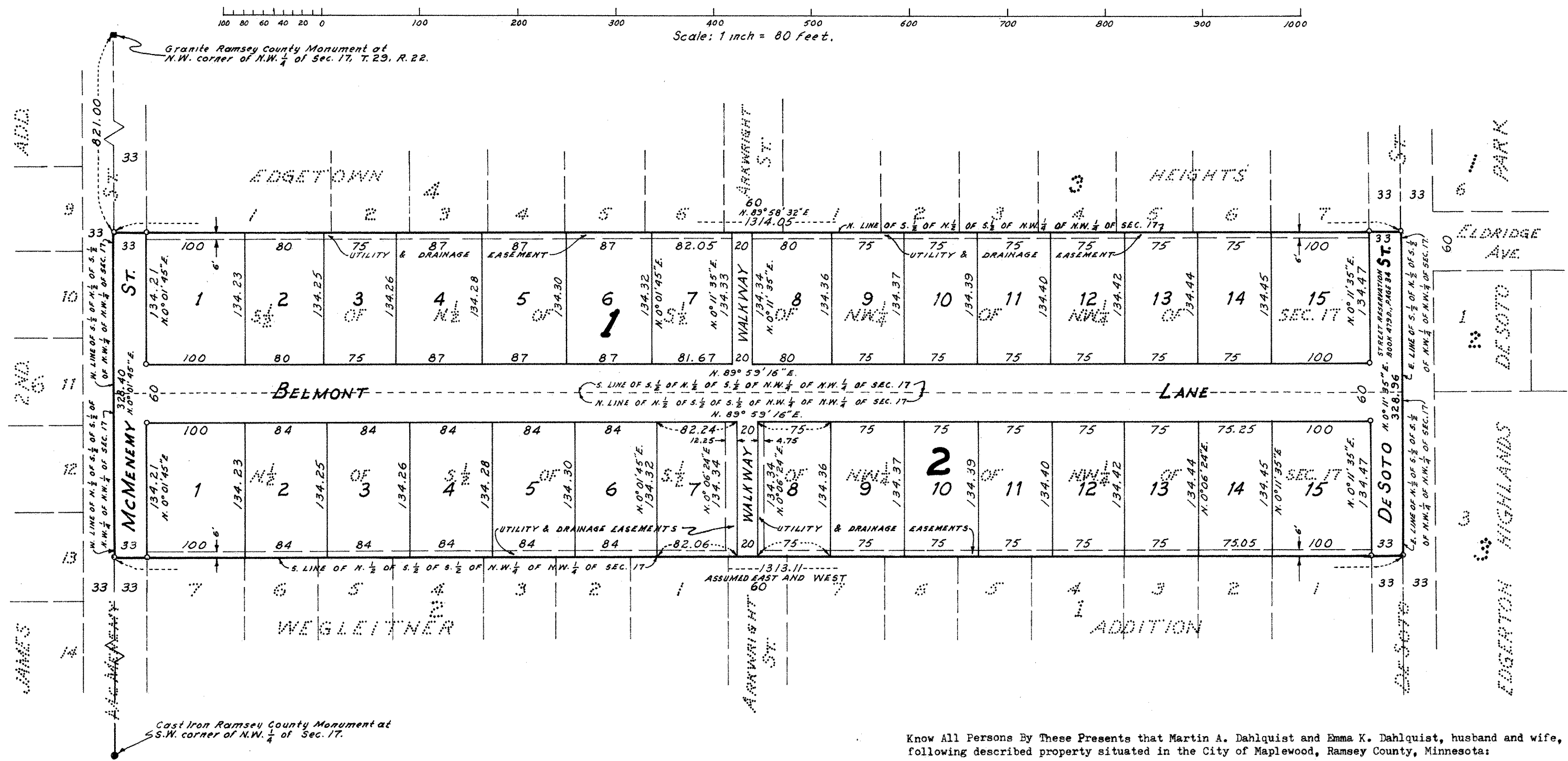


# DE MARS 10TH ADDITION
